Its 42 bright and spacious rooms have been recently renovated using locally sourced products and materials. Significant renovations for a premium experience

When renovating its rooms, the Hôtel de l'ITHQ collaborated closely with **Ædifica**, an architecture and design firm deeply committed to sustainable development in its projects. Throughout the renovation process, the Hôtel de l'ITHQ was enthusiastic about **showcasing Québec's expertise** in every facet of its lodging offerings, whether by advocating for local materials or fostering partnerships with local artists, artisans, and producers.

The Hôtel de l'ITHQ's dedication to **eco-responsible initiatives** has been acknowledged with the prestigious **Clé Verte®** certification, a globally recognized environmental assessment accreditation for the hotel industry. Additionally, the establishment secured **Kéroul** certification, the sole certification accredited by Québec's Ministère du Tourisme, confirming its accessibility to individuals with restricted physical abilities. Furthermore, the Hôtel de l'ITHQ proudly holds the **Bienvenue cyclistes!** certification, providing guests with a secure area for bicycles and a kit for minor repairs.

Room aesthetics

The room designs have been meticulously crafted to provide guests with an authentic Montréal experience, **invoking the allure of the Plateau Mont-Royal's architectural legacy**. The incorporation of white oak in the custom-built furnishings draws inspiration from the built-in china cabinets and decorative oak woodwork commonly found in Plateau apartments. Additionally, the conventional commercial wallpaper typically encountered in hotel rooms has been supplanted by a delicately textured limewash paint that mirrors the plaster walls found in the neighbourhood's residences. Crafted from marble dust, this traditional wall covering boasts durability and naturally possesses alkaline, antistatic, antifungal, and hypoallergenic properties.

Moreover, the **corridor designs are intentionally curated to metamorphose these transitional spaces into a platform for showcasing Québec artists**, in collaboration with the esteemed **Gallea gallery**. The deep blue hue, influenced by the ITHQ's distinctive colour palette, is complemented by carpets in corresponding tones adorned with linear patterns. This choice evokes the undulating movement of water and subtly alludes to the St. Lawrence River, which can be glimpsed from select rooms in the hotel.

The arrangement of our various rooms caters to the diverse clientele of the ITHQ Hotel. **Families** benefit from the convenience of foldaway beds, the option to create a cozy living space, and the availability of connecting rooms to enhance their experience. **Business travellers**, on the other hand, enjoy an improved workspace with more generous office facilities. **Those with reduced mobility** are provided with specially designed rooms that prioritize their comfort and inclusivity.

To enhance room acoustics, several measures have been undertaken, including the incorporation of cork flooring.

In a commitment to supporting local craftsmanship, the cabinetry for both the bedrooms and corridors was exclusively crafted in Québec, utilizing predominantly local and Canadian materials.

The decorative lighting fixtures in the bedrooms primarily feature selections from the Luminaire Authentik collections, while the mattresses are also made in Québec.

Adorning the hotel's corridors and rooms is the "Art d'ici" exhibition, showcasing 85 pieces by 23 Québec visual artists. These artworks are easily accessible for purchase with just a simple click.
