



Terms and conditions for bringing pets to the Hôtel de l'ITHQ

Welcome to the Hôtel de l'ITHQ! We look forward to providing you and your furry friend with an unforgettable stay. For our guests' comfort and enjoyment, the following terms and conditions will apply to the pet you wish to bring with you to the hotel.

1. Pet occupancy fee

No matter how long you stay, an additional non-refundable fee of CA\$100.00 before taxes will be charged for room cleaning, even if your pet has non-allergenic fur.

2. Maximum number of pets

Only one pet per room is allowed.

3. Allowed pets

We only allow dogs and cats. The animal must comply with the pet regulations established by the Ville de Montréal. Your animal must not be aggressive or have fleas. You must provide proof of your pet's vaccination, only take your pet to the assigned spaces, and immediately clean up after your pet by placing any droppings in the designated containers.

4. Pet-free areas

Pets are not allowed in public areas where meals are served or consumed or in any other client area, including our restaurants, the bar Blanc bec and the student café, unless the animals are guide or assistance dogs.

5. Controlling your animal

Your animal must be trained and under your control at all times. It must be kept on a leash at all times when outside your room. EVERY TIME you need to leave your pet alone in your room, you must notify and advise the

reception about how to contact you in the event of a problem.

6. Housekeeping

Housekeeping will only enter your room when your pet is not there or when you are there and can supervise your pet.

7. Responsibility

The guest or anyone keeping the pet on site will be responsible for any type of damage caused by the pet's behaviour and agrees to be responsible for the costs from any claim or damage related to the pet with regard to the hotel, employees, hotel guests or other clients. The hotel reserves the right to charge the guest for any damage to the premises caused by their pet. The hotel will request the immediate departure of any animal exhibiting dangerous or unacceptable behaviour (biting, scratching, excessive barking, an apparent illness, defecation in public places), without any reduction in the cost of the remaining stay.

8. Applicable law and judicial district

These terms and conditions shall be interpreted and governed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Quebec. The parties hereby elect domicile in the judicial district of Montreal.
